Headteacher's Message

Children in Reception and Year 1 have been learning about road safety this week with a visit from the Warwickshire Road Safety Team. Among other things, children in Reception have learnt the importance of holdings hands with an adult and stopping at the kerbside, before crossing the road.

In Year 1, the children learned about adults who can help them cross the road.

The Road Safety Team will be returning in the Spring to work with the Year 2 children.

All the children have been taught the following:

THINK about roads STOP before the kerb LOOK and LISTEN for traffic THINK about what to do CROSS safely, looking and listening all the time

You may have noticed our recent road markings on the playground. The Warwickshire Road Safety Team arranged for these to be installed so we have a space to teach children about crossing the road. Parents can find out more about road safety <u>here</u>.
