You may have noticed that we do not have the year group pages on our newsletter... we promise that there is a very good reason why!

We are very excited to tell you that from next week we will be launching Class Dojo!

Class Dojo is a tool that allows us to connect and communicate with families.

Millions of families world-wide use ClassDojo to have a window into their child's day at school. Parents with ClassDojo accounts can see a Class Story (where teachers will write messages, make announcements, schedule events and share photos and videos) and directly message their child's class teacher through a private messaging function.

Class Dojo is 100% free for teachers, parents and pupils. It is easy to log on and can be accessed via an app or internet browser. Messages sent on Class Dojo can be translated into over 35 different languages.

Class Teachers will be sending paper invitations home with each child on **Monday 11th September** and each invitation will include instructions with how to sign up using a unique code to link your parent account with their pupil account.
