# Headteacher's Message

From time to time parents want to take their child out of school during term-time. I understand why they would want to do this; there is a significant mark-up on the cost of vacations during school holidays. Forms are available from the School Office which parents use to ask permission and if the request meets the definition of 'exceptional circumstances', leave will be granted. It is up to the Headteacher in each school to decide what they consider 'exceptional circumstances' to be. Whilst there isn't the space here to give an exhaustive list of times when authorised leave has been granted by me, I am happy to talk to parents about this in more detail should they want to know more.

Where children are taken out of school at times when they shouldn't, the absence is recorded as unauthorised. You may have seen in the news that there have been cases where parents have been prosecuted for taking their children out of school. This is something which can only be actioned by the local authority, not the school.

There have been four occasions this week when children have had an unauthorised absence recorded. When I discuss this issue with parents they are sometimes under the impression that other parents have been allowed to take their children out of school with my permission. I would like to make it clear that when parents do this, it is not with my permission.
