	NURSERY Rainbow Room The children have been having great fun printing with potatoes of different sizes, using the language of size and showing they can identify which is which. They have also loved using the large interactive screen to access the painting program using their gross motor skills to make lots of marks. Outside the children have been rolling conkers and themselves down the hill. They have had races and really used their core strength to help them. Blue Room	NURSERY  The children have loved exploring the dark tent this week using the technological resources, as well as recognising amounts of items in there and making marks to represent them. Little Owls	RECEPTION  We have all been on a Bear Hunt! We found the bear and completed lots of lovely activities to do with the story. The children were very well behaved both on the bus and at the Botanic Gardens. We went on an Autumn walk and the children enjoyed experimenting with the sycamore seeds, they investigated the different coloured autumn leaves that we found and the spikes on the conker shells.  We read the 'Leaf Man' story and used Alphablock letters to segment to spell. The children practised their careful counting in Maths by counting irregular arrangements.	Elf Owls
Barn Owls	YEAR ONE In phonics this week we have been learning the alternative ways of making the 'ai' sound. We have been reading the story 'Lost in the Toy museum' and have been sequencing the story and making predictions. We have also been applying our use of capital letters and full stops. In maths we have been learning to find the whole on a part whole model and by using a numberline. In topic this week we have looked at the painting Children's games by Brugel. Spectacled Owls	YEAR TWO Year 2 this week have been understanding links between part, part whole models and have written addition and subtraction sentences linked with these. In literacy an exciting letter made an entrance from the character Grandad from 'Grandad's Island' so the children have written a letter back. 
