## HEADTEACHER'S MESSAGE

With December about to start it is perhaps timely to talk about what would happen in the event of bad weather. When considering whether a school should close the main issues are whether enough staff can get to the site and the state of the premises. Historically we have tried to keep both schools open as much as possible, but a consequence of this is that decisions were made quite late. I consulted parents on this matter in 2018 and the majority favoured an earlier decision even though this risks the school being closed the night before and weather improving overnight. We will therefore seek to reach a decision about the following day by 7.30PM. Parents/carers will receive a text message if the school is closed. Please make sure the school's record of your contact details are up to date.

School was closed, for pupils at least, for a different reason last Friday when we held a training day. The staff had training which was largely the same across both the infants and the juniors. We looked at maths, special educational needs and regulations relating to GDPR among other things. Our next training day is Monday 6th January with children returning to school on Tuesday 7th.

All families are invited to the Dunchurch Christmas Lights Switch On this Sunday in the centre of the village near St. Peter's Church. The event will start at 4PM.

If this causes a problem, please speak to Mr Dewes or Mrs Barnes, or leave a message for them at the School Office.




