HEADTEACHER'S MESSAGE

Starting from Monday we will have a new system for when children have bumped their head. Currently, a minor bump results in a slip being sent home to parents. This means parents can see that their child has had a minor accident and they should watch out for signs of concussion. Often these slips get buried at the bottom of the bag and may not be noticed. (Although of course in more serious cases there would be verbal contact between home and school). From Monday, as well as the existing provision, there will also be wristbands given to children. These will simply say "I bumped my head in school today". There will still be the more detailed slips and sometimes phone calls, but they will be a visual prompt that the child has hurt their head and there is chance (albeit small) that they may show signs of concussion. This will also help staff, as much as parents. Children of course do not stay with the same adult all day, so this will make it easier for staff to know if there has been an incident earlier in the day. The bands will have the date written on them, but it is still important that parents remove the bands before children come into school the next day.

Occasionally the weather is too bad for children to go outside at lunchtime or playtime and the children stay in their classrooms. Some of our classes are short of toys for the children to play with, so if you have any items that your children no longer play with or if you are having an early Spring clean, we would be happy to accept any donations.

We read the story of 'Cleversticks' and the children applied their phonetic knowledge well to write simple sentences.

In Handwriting we finished our recap of the One-Armed Robot letters and we have had a big emphasis on retracing the vertical lines! The children have loved using the Bingo Dabbers to complete the number hunt in Continuous. We started our learning on 'One More' in Maths, we will be leading on to 'One Less' soon...

YEAR ONE

This week in year one we have been continuing our learning about the local area. We have been learning about physical and human features of the school grounds and Dunchurch village and have been comparing them to other places. We have read the story 'The house held up by trees' and have been predicting, sequencing and making inferences. In maths we have been using numbers to 20 to add and subtract and have been making links between number bonds. E.g. If I know that 5 and 2 is 7 then I also know 15 and 2 is 17. If I know that 8 and 2 is 10 then I know that 18 and 2 is 20 and 8 and 12 is 20. The children have been finding this tricky. 
All school children will be joining in on Wednesday afternoon at the Junior school and you can make a monetary donation during that week.


