As you will have seen from previous correspondence, we are constantly reviewing our procedures in an attempt to make sure school is as safe a place as possible. Not all changes affect pupils and parents directly, but the following table summarises some things which you or your child(ren) are likely to notice:

The requirement for parents to wear masks when collecting and picking up at the Infants and Nursery is something I would rather not have introduced, but we have been increasingly concerned at the number of parents in fairly confined spaces. We have also had quite a lot parents speaking to staff while in quite close proximity. Communication with parents is vital and is not something we want to discourage, so we think masks would help for the time being. We are not requiring this at the Juniors. Far fewer parents are on the school site as the children are older. Like all things, we will keep this under review.

Before half-term we will hold a COVID-influenced version of Parent Evenings. Unsurprisingly, we will not be holding the normal face-to-face meetings. We did consider holding video calls online, but we thought that it would be difficult to keep to time with new meetings being started every ten minutes; one breakdown in the technology could significantly delay subsequent calls. Instead we will phone parents. Further details will follow in due course.
