Dear parents/carers and children,

It has been another busy week in both schools and the weather has really challenged us at times. Hail in May was a real excitement for the children!

Year 1 have enjoyed planting their beans and watching them grow and year 5 have enjoyed attending Space Camp and staying in school until 10pm. This has provided great learning opportunities for our children and I would like to thank all staff who stayed at school late this week. Year 3 have started their intense swimming lessons and I have been impressed with their behaviour and attitudes.

The children are currently completing a unit in P.S.H.E. through Jigsaw about relationships. This Jigsaw piece looks at issues relating to e-safety, so now would be a good opportunity to discuss with your child how they can keep themselves safe online thinking about the devices you have at home eg. mobile phones, games consoles, iPad etc.
