Virtual trip to the farm from Yew Tree Farm School

The aim is to make the tours as interactive as possible, children will be able to ask questions during the session and get answers straight away.

Tours last for an hour and includes meeting all the animals on the farm.

We will:

Meet our chickens, ducks and geese - Feed them and collect the eggs. Most of our poultry we have hatched ourselves on the farm so we will talk about this process.

Meet our pygmy goats - Feed them and learn about their cheeky antics, meet our sheep and our lambs, meet Maisie the Shetland pony - Talk about how we care for her, meet our little piglets and meet our rabbits and guinea pigs.

The tour will then end with a story or a quiz. There may even be a token appearance from the farm cat if he is feeling sociable!

Each class has a session booked for them and a separate email will go out to the parents/carers of the date. A payment item has been set up on ParentPay for the £2 charge per child.

Zimbe! Vocal Project

Fifteen Year 5 pupils have recently been working very hard to rehearse and record two South African songs – *Thula Mama* and *Freedom is Coming* – as part of a Warwickshire Music singing project. The group met for five consecutive Wednesday lunch times to rehearse and learn about apartheid in South Africa. Mothers would sing the gentle lullaby "Thula Mama" to provide comfort in times of separation, and the Year 5 vocal bubble learnt to sing the words in the South African language of Xhosa. The second song was called "Freedom is Coming", and although also South African, the words are in English. This song provided a jubilant contrast.

Our two recordings are currently on the Year 5 Seesaw class pages, but they will be added to performances created by other schools. Warwickshire Music are going to create one big performance video for us, so we will post this final video on the Year 5 Seesaw pages and on the school website when we receive it in mid-July.

I would like to extend my heartfelt thanks to the following Year 5 pupils for participating in this project. The girls were such a joy to work with, and achieved a high performance standard in only a few rehearsals. Well done!
