Dear parents/carers and children,

I am sure our whole school community are happy about the decisions by the Government to allow schools to return to some normality in September. However, I can understand that many people will have some concerns linked to this. As a school, we will be maintaining our current COVID secure routines up to and including the 22/7/21. This is the guidance that the Local Education Authority are recommending to all schools. I also do not want to increase the risk of any child or staff member catching COVID and having to self-isolate at the start of the school holiday.

COVID- We will be following this guidance from August 2021

Here is a summary of the main points from the document

- No longer a recommendation that it is necessary to keep children in consistent bubbles from Autumn term
- Assemblies can resume in halls
- Mixing at lunch and break is allowed
- No staggered entry and exit times
- Outbreak Management plan in place and reintroduction of bubbles if there is an outbreak (several confirmed cases in 14 days) and advised by public health
- Close contacts will be identified via NHS Test and Trace and education settings will no longer be expected to undertake contact tracing
- From 16th August 2021, children under the age of 18 will no longer be required to self-isolate if they are contacted by NHS Test and Trace as a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case. They will be advised to take a PCR test.
- Face coverings are no longer recommended to be worn in classrooms, communal areas and on dedicated public transport
- Ensure good hygiene
- Maintain cleaning regimes
- Well ventilated spaces
- Pupils, staff and other adults should follow public health advice on when to self-isolate and what to do
- Pupils, staff and other adults should not come into school if they have symptoms and access a PCR test
- If anyone develops symptoms, however mild, they should be sent home and follow public health advice
- Pupil or staff with symptoms should be left in a designated room with ventilation
- Staff should undertake twice weekly home tests, whenever they are on site until the end of September, when this will be reviewed
- Staff and pupils with a positive LFD test result should self-isolate. They will need to access a PCR test to check if they have COVID. Isolate whilst waiting for the result. If the PCR test is taken within 2 days of the positive LFT and is negative, the pupil can return to school, as long as the individual doesn't have COVID 19 symptoms
- Schools should maintain the capacity to deliver high quality remote education for the next academic year

Reports- These have been sent home today. If you have any concerns about your child's report, please book a telephone conversation with the class teacher. You will need to email the office on the 12th July to request a telephone appointment on 13th July. 4B will receive their report on Monday 12th July, so will need to email the office on the morning of the 13th of July, if they need an appointment. **This is only if you have a concern about the report.**

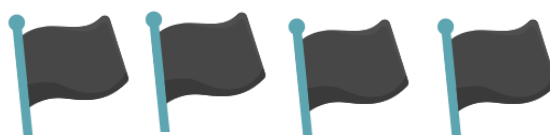

If you test positive for Covid 19/coronavirus, please contact the school immediately via email to the following address: tracymiller@dunchurfederation.co.uk

If you have any of the main symptoms of COVID-19 (a high temperature, a new continuous cough or loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)

- Get a PCR test (test that is sent to a lab) to check if you have COVID-19 as soon as possible.
- You and anyone you live with should stay at home and not have visitors until you get your test result.
