Reception

It has been lovely to see the sun this week! Reception have enjoyed being outside and taking part in the different learning activities. Leading on from Lucy's Picture from last week we talked about being blind and the work of guide dogs. The children had a go at being blindfolded and led around by a 'guide'. I'm pleased to say that we had no injuries, so the guides did a good job!

This week in maths we have looked at 3 D shapes. We have found lots of shapes around the classroom as everyday objects. The children learnt to describe the shapes using mathematical language including 'faces'.

They found out that shapes with flat faces are good for building and shapes with curved faces are good for rolling.

We have read the story of Dear Zoo and then had a go at writing parts of the story with lots of tricky words. In phonics we have read and written longer words such as carpark and bedroom.
